Minneriya National Park's varying natural habitats; coastal belt, natural lakes (villus), rocky outcrops, scrublands, open grasslands and dense forest provide for numerous species of animals. The biggest draws in are Leopards (Panthera pardus kotiya) and Sloth bears (Melursus ursinus), Asian Elephants (Elephas maximus), Spotted Deer, Barking Deer, jackals, sambhur, barking deer, mouse deer Wild Pig, Crocodiles etc



Explore the monument known as **Lion Rock** (where visitors used to ascend through an eerie, jaw-like entrance in the rock)This Sigiriya Rock fortress is known as the '8th wonder of the world' and is a haven for stunning fresco's, winding rock stairways and a breathtaking view from the top.

Dambulla cave temple also known as the Golden Temple of Dambulla is a World Heritage Site in Sri Lanka. The stunning Dambulla Cave Temple is the main attraction in Dambulla. It looks back on a **history of 2100 years** and comes with a unique atmosphere, 151 Buddha statues. On top of all, every single square millimeter is painted with amazing wall paintings, which help to create this venerable ambiance.
